Sample Essay Prompts

- 2. The lessons we take from obstacles we encounter can be fundamental to later success. Recount a time when you faced a challenge, setback or failure. How did it affect you, and what did you learn from the experience?
- 3. Reflect on a time when questioned or challenged a belief or idea. What prompted your thinking? What was the outcome?
- 4. Describe a problem you've solved or a problem you would like to solve. It can be an intellectual challenge, a research query, or an ethical dilemma. Explain its significance to you and what steps you too or could take to identify a solution.
- 5. Discuss an accomplishment, event, or realization that sparked a period of personal growth and new understanding of yourself or others.
- 6. Describe a topic, idea or concept you find so engaging that it makes you lose all track of time. Why does it captivate you? What or who do you turn to when you want to learn more?
- 7. Share an essay on any topic of your choice.
