

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Can we use labels for our envelopes, so we don't have to handwrite addresses every year?

Yes, you may use address labels on the envelopes and on the donor letter itself in the donor information section as long as it has all the required information.

2. Can my child send a letter to themselves?

Yes, if your child would like to donate to Patriot Project, they may send a letter to themselves. This is a terrific way for them to learn how they can impact the Kingdom of God with their financial blessings.

3. What happens if my child does not turn in the minimum letters by the deadline?

They will not receive the free tardy incentive. If they turn in the minimum letters but not the 5 extra letters, elementary students <u>will not</u> receive their 2nd free tardy and secondary students <u>will not</u> receive a NO DRESS UP CHAPEL DAY!

4. Are there prizes?

Yes! Visa gift cards will be awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd place winners for both most money raised AND most donors.

5. If I have a donor giving to more than one of my children, can they write one check?

Yes, if you have more than one student sending a letter to the same donor, the donor may mail only one check. **HOWEVER**, the donor MUST return the bottom of <u>each donor letter</u> for ALL of your students! Please understand this is for data entry purposes and so EACH student signs a thank you note for their sponsors. **If donors are donating online, they will need to make separate online donations for each child.**

6. I have more than two students. If we send in our family minimum of 30 letters, will they still receive credit for sending in their individual minimum number of letters?

Yes, for all families with 2 or more students who send in the family minimum of 30 letters, each student receives credit. **HOWEVER**, each student will have to send in an extra 5 letters to receive their extra incentive. For example, a family with 3 students would need to turn in their family minimum of 30 letters plus an extra 5 for each student bringing their total to 45 letters or 15 letters for each student. Use the letters in your packet, visit the Website to print more, or send the online donation link to friends and family via text or email.

7. How does the money get distributed to the organization codes we assign on our donor letters?

Each letter returned with an org code counts for 1 vote toward that organization. After all donations are in, these votes are tallied and the % of votes towards that organization is the % of money that organization receives.
