

Tips & Tricks for Patriot Project

- To save on postage, you are welcome to keep letters addressed to yourself and any
 others you are going to hand deliver. You are also free to mail letters yourself or choose
 to send only online links and no letters. All these options should be included in your totals
 on the orange slip under "*Number of Letters Hand Delivered or Mailed Already" or*"*Number of Texts/E-mails Sent Out with Online Donation Link".* Please be sure to return
 any unused letters and envelopes in your manila envelope along with your student's
 Letter/Link Count orange slip.
- <u>If mailing any letters on your own, YOU must stamp them</u>. The "postage paid" box on the envelopes is only for the bulk mail letters turned in to the school by the deadline.
- When returning envelopes on bulk mail day, <u>all envelopes MUST be sealed and</u> <u>addressed</u>, BEFORE they are turned in.
- Parents are welcome to work with their child on Patriot Project day, but it is NOT required. Our hope is that each volunteer working alongside their student is setting a great example of a servant's heart. Please keep this in mind when registering volunteers for Patriot Project day.
- T-shirts and meals are provided for two volunteers per family. If a family has more than two volunteers, a cost of \$10 is added to help cover expenses. Payment can be received at either school office, please mark the envelope, "Patriot Project Extra Volunteers."
